- 9) Possession of weapons or dangerous chemicals of any kind is strictly prohibited.
- 10) Students will not get involved in political activities of any sort or participate in any anti-national and anti-social or undesirable activity inside or outside the campus.
- 11) Students are not permitted to stay in rooms during the college hours, unless they are ill. Any illness and medication student uses should be reported to the Warden. and principal.
